## **Jämi 75 Years Anniversary Air Show in July 2010.**

Jämi airfield, located in Jämijärvi at Finland, will celebrate its 75 year aviation history on 10th - 11th July 2010 when during the Jämi fly-in aviation event the biggest air show so far will be organized. Jämi is well known for a recreational flying and especially as a cradle of gliding which will bring one of the last year stars aerobatic glider pilot Christoph Zahn back this year as well from Germany. Zahn will fly with DFS Habicht E glider (the model is designed in 1936) dashing aerobatics synchronized to music.

Other stars of the show will be almost all aerobatic pilots from Finland, a Fouga Magister jet trainers, a Flying Circus model airplane group known also from television, first time at the Jämi a flying British Second World War fighter Supermarine Spitfire Mk. XVI and its German foe genuine wreck of Messerschmitt Bf 109 from the Aviation Museum of Central Finland at Jämi Arena. All these and much more at Jämi 75 Years Anniversary Air Show 10th - 11th July 2010.
