World´s Highest-reaching People Lifter To Arrive at Jämi Fly-In 2010

The highest aerial platform in the world, the Bronto Skylift 104 HLA people lifter will be stationed at Jämi on July 10 and 11, 2010 and will mainly be used for lifting aviation photographers to a vantage position above the showground where they will have a unique view of what´s happening in the sky - and on the ground as well. The Skylift makes "air-to-air" photography possible from the ground - as the platform can be lifted to an altitude of 104 meters.

The working cage of the platform will accommodate five to six photographers at a time. In addition, there will be one other person on the platform observing the airspace and giving instructions to the aircraft being photographed. After the official airshow program is over, "air-to-air" pictures may be taken of any visiting aircraft who´s pilots are interested. The lifter will be available on both days for photographers who are interested in seeing the show from a bird´s perspective in a way which was previously not imaginable.
